The subjects of the afternoon concurrent sessions will include introduction of SJTU key open positions and compensation guidelines, job openings in various industries and businesses, introduction of sci-tech parks, analysis of Chinese financial market and real estate market, etc. The SJTUFA inaugural gala dinner will follow in the evening, honoring the 24th US Secretary of Labor **Elaine Chao**. The award winning SJTU Student Orchestra will perform during the gala.
